The Jefferson County Area Agency on Aging offers a variety of services to the older citizens of Jefferson County ranging from hands-on personal care to caregiver support, transportation and volunteer services. We are here to help.

Personal Care Services

Hands-on assistance with bathing, dressing and grooming. Some light housekeeping may be included.

Medication Management

Provides the set-up of medications by a Registered Nurse through a Home Health Agency to help consumers manage their health care needs.

Personal Emergency Response System Allows consumers to have a "help button" when they need emergency care.

Home Delivered Meals Nutritious frozen meals delivered to your home.

Protective Services

Safeguards the rights of older adults through training, information, educational programs and provides services to eliminate harmful actions to the older person and their property. Reports can be taken 24 hours a day by calling 800-852-8036.

Caregiver Support Program

Consult with an expert to learn the benefits available to you as a provider of care. You might be eligible for reimbursement for part of the cost of services, supplies, adaptive devices and home modifications on a cost-sharing basis.

Home Support Services

Services include: light housekeeping, grocery shopping and laundry. Services available as funding permits

Information and Assistance Referral assistance to appropriate agency services.

Care Management

Provides for implementation of Individual Service Plans and the coordination of services for in-home consumers.

Volunteer Services

Opportunities for seniors to assist other seniors in their community; includes Administrative, Ombudsman, Apprise and Volunteer Income Tax Assistance.

Ombudsman

Protects and enhances the welfare of older people in long-term care facilities.

APPRISE

Free insurance counseling on Medicare benefits.

Transportation

The Shared Ride program will provide transportation and cover costs for scheduled dentist, diagnostic test, dialysis treatment, doctor's office visits, specialists, hospital visits, pharmacy, physical therapy, surgical and to nearest senior center. Age 65 and older.
