Department of Revenue Now Distributing One-time Bonus Rebates to Property Tax/Rent Rebate Enrollees



Older adults and people with disabilities who have already received a rebate on property taxes or rent paid in 2021 will soon be receiving a one-time bonus rebate from the Department of Revenue.

PA Department of Aging Secretary, Robert Torres, travelled throughout the commonwealth earlier this year to promote Governor Tom Wolf's proposal to use American Rescue Plan Act dollars to provide the extra bonus rebate. The General Assembly passed legislation in June to offer a one-time rebate equal to 70% of recipients' original rebate amount.

For those older adults and people with disabilities who have yet to apply for their rebates, they have until December 31, 2022 to do so through

either the Department of Revenue's website or the Jefferson County Area Agency on Aging. They will receive one combined payment if they are approved.

Important Dates for the Pennsylvania 2022 General Election

Pennsylvania's 2022 General Election is November 8. While many people – including older adults – have returned to inperson voting, others have chosen to continue voting by mailin ballot. No matter how people vote this fall, here are some important dates for everyone to know:

No older adult should ever be subjected to injury, violence, neglect, abuse, exploitation, or abandonment at the hands of another. Yet, elder abuse is a problem that has increased over the years in Pennsylvania, and one of the fastest-growing types of elder abuse has been financial exploitation.

At the Department of Aging, financial exploitation ranks in the top three types of elder abuse reported to our statewide elder abuse hotline, currently accounting for 21% of all reports of suspected abuse that come in. These cases also rank third in abuse cases that are substantiated after being investigated – with a total of 1,857 substantiated for FY 2020-2021.

To assist the 52 Area Agencies on Aging (AAAs) with investigating cases of this growing crime involving older adults, Secretary of Aging Robert Torres was pleased to announce last month the launch of a new Financial Abuse Specialist Team or FAST as we refer to it.

Perpetrators of financial exploitation have many faces, and, sadly, many of them are faces older adults know and trust. A person of trust can be well-positioned to commit crimes such as property theft, misuse of income or assets, or misuse of a Power of Attorney. Then there are the threats posed by strangers -- scams of many types including medical, contractor, grandchild imposter emergencies, Social Security or IRS, fake charities, gift card scams, pension poaching and more.

In 2020, the Department of Aging recognized we needed more support on these types of cases and began a pilot program at the Blair County AAA to assist the AAAs with complicated financial cases.

The FAST team, which is comprised of a supervisor, two analysts, and an elder justice attorney, is designed to offer direct help on financial exploitation cases by:

- Analyzing and helping to make sense of financial data for the field investigators, allowing them to focus on other aspects of their investigation
- Sharing work product, where appropriate, with both law enforcement to form the basis for a criminal probe, and with the team elder justice attorney as the foundation for civil recovery actions
- Pursuing civil justice in cases where law enforcement isn't a viable option

So, what can this focused work mean with regards to mitigating damages and protecting older adults? Based on a sample of 22 cases where we exercised enhanced coordination and early intervention, nearly \$3 million in assets was able to be protected from further exploitation. And, during the pilot program period, 154 cases were identified and flagged for follow-up of what we would call "potential exploitation" of \$8.5 million.

Given these results, we decided to use \$666,000 in federal funding obtained by the Department of Aging to expand the capacity of this program for the next two years to further support our AAA network and assist older Pennsylvanians in obtaining justice.

The formation of the FAST investigative team is one part of the Department of Aging's ongoing work to protect older adults and prevent financial exploitation. You can learn more about financial exploitation by visiting the department's website. www.aging.pa.gov
