SENIOR NUTRITION PROGRAM ANNIVERSARY

This March, the Jefferson County Area Agency on Aging joins the Administration for Community Living (ACL) and senior nutrition service providers across the country in celebrating the anniversary of the national Senior Nutrition Program.

Since 1972, the Senior Nutrition Program has supported nutrition services for older adults. Funded by the Older Americans Act, local senior nutrition programs serve as hubs for older adults (60 and older) to access nutritious meals and other vital services that strengthen social connections and promote health and well-being.

Jefferson County Area Agency on Aging provides nutrition services to seniors in Jefferson County. In 2023, we served **41,944 home-delivered meals** and **18,340 meals at our four senior community centers** and the Summerville Eats



& Sweets Restaurant. That's over 60,000 meals served just in Jefferson County, Pennsylvania!

But our program goes beyond food – we work to reduce social isolation and focus on overall health and well-being. We host many activities at our senior centers daily to help get people moving and staying healthy, and we connect older adults with other community supports like local law enforcement presentations on scams, local author book signings, artists, and more.
